

# *LEROY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING MINUTES*

The Leroy Township Trustees met in regular session on Monday, July 19, 2010, at 7PM at the Leroy Township Hall.

Present were: Chuck Klco, Linda Burhenne, Richard VanPelt, and Sharon Rodgers.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted with correction of typo. (Road levy was typed incorrectly as .09, should be 0.90).

## **Department Reports:**

**ZONING:** Myron is on vacation. A letter was sent to Allegra next to BP that what is going on there is not what they applied for nor what their permit was issued for. Therefore, they are not in compliance with zoning. Also waiting to hear about Osborne's operations on Vrooman Rd. at his gas well site.

**FIRE:** The Fire Chief was working his full time shift in Painesville Twp. There have been 59 calls since last meeting, Year to date, 273. This is seventy more calls than last year at this time. The construction on I-90 East bound has increased our calls because of accidents.

**ROAD:** Charlie reported some seal coating and ditching was done. Men are currently working on dust control. Seeley was completed today, and Chadwick will be tomorrow. Also side rd. mowing is being done.

**CEMETERIES:** Charlie talked to Norman Monuments, they monument for the VFW memorial is not done. Charlie will inform the VFW. Rich needs to know the size of the plaque for the Paine Rd. cemetery.

**PARKS:** Linda reported the Pig roast was well attended, which was sponsored by the softball committee. The rec. board participated with pie baking contest, and photo contest. They also donated \$250.00 towards purchase of a pig for the dinner.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Chuck Klco made a motion to submit resolution 10-17 to the voters of Leroy Twp. for a 0.90 mil continuous road material only levy, for the repair, improvement and maintenance of township roads. Rich VanPelt seconded the motion. Poll of the vote: Klco, aye, Burhenne, aye, VanPelt, aye. Resolution to be filed by August 4<sup>th</sup>, and appear on the November 2<sup>nd</sup> ballot.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Chuck made a motion to approve the tentative tax budget for 2011, to be submitted to the auditor's office by Tues. July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Rich VanPelt. Poll of the vote: Klco aye, Burhenne, aye, VanPelt, aye.

Motion by Chuck Klco to approve agreement for Leroy Twp. road employees to sign, wherein if Leroy Township pays for a class for them to attend, that unless due to personal or family illness or injury they will complete the class. If they fail to complete the class, the employee must reimburse the township for the cost of the class. Linda seconded the motion, all were in favor.

**FISCAL OFFICER:** Motion by Chuck Klco to transfer interest of \$1.75 into Motor Vehicle and \$3.61 into Gas Tax from GF interest earned in high yield savings. Linda seconded the motion, all were in favor.

Motion to pay all bills made by, Chuck Klco, seconded by Linda, all were in favor.

Next meeting: August 10<sup>th</sup> TUESDAY at 7pm

Audience: Frank Kuturo from Leroy/Thompson Rd. complained about his neighbors being noisy and the length of response time from the Sheriff's Dept.

The method used to figure the cost of a levy to the homeowner was explained. Take the TAX VALUE of your home, multiply by .35%, take that amount, multiply by the amount of mileage, take that amount, multiply by 12.5% rollback, subtract that amount from the .35% amount, and that is what you will pay yearly. Your Tax valuation can be found on the auditor's web site.
