

LERROY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING MINUTES

The Leroy Township Trustees met in regular session on Monday March 1, 2010.
Present were: Chuck Klco, Linda Burhenne, and Richard VanPelt.

Guests: Leroy Softball members were present. Gary Ball discussed future plans for ball field, and their carryover balance. Two sets of bleachers, 3 tier for the T-Ball area. They would also like to build a pole building possibly 24x40. The location is to be determined. Also want to purchase a golf cart to use for dragging the fields, can store in new pole building. With a utility cart the cost would be around \$2,000.00. Need to check with insurance as to coverage. They also have someone looking into any grants available. They will check with zoning regarding building regulations. Anthony Dworning would like to do a project at the park to earn his Eagle Scout badge.

Minutes of the previous meeting were not read.

Correspondence: A copy of the letter from ODOT to the residents of Vrooman Rd. regarding the bridge was received.

Department Reports:

ZONING: Myron reported 10 calls since last meeting. Two permits issued. One is a permit for an agriculture barn 49 x 141 ft. This cannot be used as a church. They would need a conditional use permit. Three inspections are completed, 17 are open. There are 10 open investigations. Three applications received for Appeals Board, two interviews will be scheduled.

FIRE: 24 calls since the last meeting. Pancake Breakfast is April 18th. Our rescue squads need to be certified.

ROAD: Lots of man-hours plowing snow. Sheriff Dept. was called about cars parked in the cul-de-sac on end of Lester. Snow can't be plowed when cars are parked on road. The side road mower tractor is ordered. .

CEMETERIES: The men are going to look at a walk behind mower for cemeteries for use between head stones

PARKS: The Easter egg hunt is Sunday March 28th, 1pm, behind the fire station or in the community room.

OLD BUSINESS: none

NEW BUSINESS: Trustees passed a recognition resolution for Gerri Hausch recognizing her dedication to the Veterans of Foreign Wars and Ladies Auxiliary, as commander and president of Lake, Geauga County Council.
